SOUTHERN REGION SENATES EMELDA C. GREENWOOD EDUCATION BENEFIT AWARD

PURPOSE:

To assist deserving students in continuing their education in certified institutions of higher learning or vocational and trade schools.

To contribute a monetary donation of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) designated for both male and female recipients. If both sexes do not apply, the award may be given to the same sex applicant, even if they have already received it.

To encourage education to any student who wants to further their education, whether they are entering college or already in college.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Must have a high school diploma or be the owner of an earned GED. Applicants must be able to present acceptance papers from the college or Institution, including grades and transcripts from their last year of high school. (First-year college or trade school students only). Students already in college will only need to submit the applicant award form, an acceptance letter of enrollment from the school they are attending, along with their grades, attendance records, and community-service involvement.

Applicant must be an immediate relative of an adult who is a member of the TNBA Southern Region Senates or a Junior Bowler residing in the Southern Region.

REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must show stability and consistency in past endeavors of three (3) letters of recommendation. (First-year students only)

The letter must include how long and under what circumstance you are acquainted with the applicant.

Letters of recommendation must come from one (1) relative and two (2) community members, church, school, or work. The letter must include a brief statement on the character of the Nominee.

APPLICATION COVER LETTER:

The cover letter should include your name, address, city, state, zip code, telephone, and email address of the Nominee, sender, and TNBA representative.

Applicants must include a brief description of their future intentions after completing his/her education. (For both new students and students already in college).

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

The SRSC Scholarship Chairperson must receive applications by **APRIL 30**. Students already in college applications must be received by **AUGUST 15**.
